Impact Story of Single women

She is Suntali Tamang currently living in Harisiddhi Lalitpur. She is a widow with 2 children (one daughter and one son). Her Husband Died due to the sickness. Since then she is the only breadwinner of the Family. Few years before she had taken the Agriculture training from Rise and Shine Nepal and got the opportunity to work in the agriculture of Rise and Shine Nepal.

After working with the Rise and shine Nepal for 2 years, she got the practical knowledge to grow and take care of the vegetables.

Nowadays she is working in an agriculture firm and earning Rs 10000 monthly. Also she is doing agriculture by taking a piece of land on rent. From the income by selling the vegetables it helps her to buy basic things in need.





Small business support (Laxmi Maharjan)

As people are facing a financial crisis globally, our single women could not part from it.

Being a single woman playing many roles at a time is so difficult. But being a mother this difficulty cannot limit single women. With the support of Rise and Shine Nepal, Miss laxmi maharjan has been selling clothes on the street and earning for her liveli-



hood. In the initial phase she was shy to sell on the street but now she has learned many things by doing this business and it has encouraged her to continue it. Some day she sells up to 15000 Nepalese rupees. So she is really thankful to Rise and Shine Nepal for being the helping hand in her need.

MED follow-up (Suffering from blood cancer)

She is a widow with 3 kids. She is one of our Revolving fund receivers. She was doing very well in her business before the covid-19. After the covid she is diagnosed with blood cancer and she has to spend her income on her medical expenses, her income wasn't sufficient for her medical expenses so she got support and

she is taking medicine regularly. But due to weak financial conditions she could not expand her small business. Nowadays she is facing difficulties adding the things in her shop. And this is the only way to earn for her livelihood



Agriculture

As we know Rise and shine Nepal has purchased the land in kavre district And growing fruit plants (orange, lemon, and citrus) in it. Now we have purchased two cows and we have hired a person (who does not have a place to live and his wife has left him) to tend cows and land. And we are selling milk daily and we are using it to feed cows and also support the workers.







In this land we have grown maze and coriander, cucumber and many more. Now we have planted potato there. And ready to harvest vegetable we have brought the vegetable to the nakhipot and sell it. Due to the lack of transportation facility and geographical difficulty we are not being able to bring veritable on time to sale.
